Concept Clinics

There are times when one of our family members requires dental treatment and is either unable or not eligible to access the NHS dental services and we have found that there are few dentists who are prepared to visit within the home. We do have somewhere that is willing to come to us here at Landermeads and we use the services of Concept Clinics.

Concept Clinics are due to visit again in May for their routine check ups which means if anyone would like to register their relative then now is the time. Registration means that:

- Each person will be seen automatically every 6 months for a check up.
- They will be able to access emergency treatment as and when needed.

A registration form and price list is included with this newsletter and if you are interested this needs to be completed and returned to us by the end of April. Unfortunately, there will not be a chance for any new registrants after the date until the next 6 monthly check up. *Concept Clinics aren't able to take emergency referrals unless someone is registered.*

'Greening the Grey' Competition
