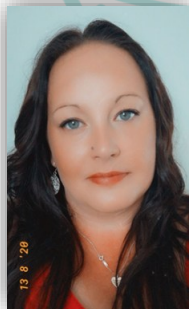
They will be available to measure family members for shoes or slippers and help find something comfortable and suitable for them.
